Packaging firm Nordenia expands German plant

Nordenia, a Germany-based provider of flexible packaging and films to OEM firms, is expanding its production and administration plant in Steinfeld.

The expansion includes a new printing press to expand production capacity, while the company says it can now store raw and packaging materials on site. Nordenia now has some 1,700m² for production and 300m² for administration at the plant.

"Thanks to the larger space, we were able to create more effective and simplified processes while boosting employee motivation," says managing director Werner Zerhusen in a press release. "And we also have the potential to expand further."

However, the company refused to say how much it invested in the expansion when contacted by *European Plastics News*.

Nordenia supplies OEM firms, primarily in Germany, France and the UK, with products such as seat covers and masking films.

The company says it expects to post "a successful fiscal 2009" at the end of the year.
